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Dr Heidi Haavik Taylor will be presenting her groups current research investigating the neuromodulatory changes that occur with spinal adjustments. She will explain their findings and how this relates to you in practice, and how it impacts us as a profession.

Dr Heidi Haavik Taylor has worked in the area of human sensorimotor physiology for the past ten years. She has utilised somatosensory evoked potential and transcranial magnetic stimulation techniques to investigate the effects of chiropractic adjustments on somatosensory processing, sensorimotor integration and motor cortical output. Dr Taylor was awarded a New Zealand Government Top Achievers

Doctoral Scholarship to support her through her PhD degree that she received from the University of Auckland.

Dr Taylor is currently the Director of Research at the New Zealand College of Chiropractic where she has established two human neurophysiology research laboratories. Dr Taylor has published a number of award winning papers. She is on the Editorial Board of the Journal of Manipulative and Physiological Therapeutics and the Journal of Chiropractic Education. She was named Chiropractor of the year in 2007 by both the New Zealand Chiropractic Association and the New Zealand College of Chiropractic Alumni Association.
